Dear Parents of the Lower Sixth

As you are aware the examination season began this week. The Lower Sixth have been informed that during the examination period, study leave will only be the day before they sit an examination. If an examination falls on a Monday, then the Friday can be used for study leave. Study leave is for the boys to prepare either at home or in school where staff will be available in their timetabled periods. This change has occurred due to the reduced number of AS examinations that the students are sitting which is a direct result of the change from modular to linear examinations.

On completion of their AS examinations students will be expected to attend all lessons in all subjects. However, if they are certain that they will not be continuing the subject next year they will be required to attend the lesson but will be need to bring work from a subject they are continuing.

Registration Day for subject choices into the Upper Sixth is Friday 7th July. Students will be required to identify the subjects they wish to continue to full A Level. However, changes in the light of AS results can be made on Results Day.
