<p><b>3 Examination Paper Project</b> (Term 2/3)</p>	<p>The examination paper is release by AQA for the end of January. Students then must produce a project (the same format as a coursework project although is critical study tends to be a little shorter in length) over the coming term. The final 15hrs examination in Art normally takes place during the second or third week after the Easter break. By the time of the examination students must have completed all project work and then must produce a piece of Final Art work during the 15 hr exam.</p>	<p>As above.</p>
