St. Ambrose College GCSE students achieved the Hale Barns' Catholic grammar school's best ever progress figures, the Government's new preferred indices for school attainment.

There was a 97.5% A\* to C pass rate with a stunning 22 young men gaining 10 straight A\* or A grades, with the year group achieving significantly beyond expectations in this summer's examinations, in comparison with Key Stage Two assessments.
