Newman House & Aquinas House Lenten Fundraising

Lent is from Wednesday March 1st until Thursday April 13th this year and as always at St Ambrose College will be marked by prayer, fasting and almsgiving.

Earlier this week the powerhouses of Newman and Aquinas decided to join forces in their Lenten fundraising efforts. All forms in these two Houses will be raising money for a charity called the Teenage Cancer Trust.

For anyone who doesn't know what the Teenage Cancer Trust does, here follows a short explanation. Around seven young people aged between 13 and 24 are diagnosed with cancer every single day in the United Kingdom. These young people need expert treatment and specialised support from the moment that they are diagnosed – the Teenage Cancer Trust provides this.

As many of you will know, a member of Newman House is being currently treated for cancer and is soon to fly to the USA for special treatment. Myself and Mr Rush have decided that each of the forms in Aquinas House and Newman House will raise money in recognition of this very brave young man and all the other young men and women who are battling cancer each day in the United Kingdom. Members of all Aquinas and Newman forms should spend the next couple of weeks carefully planning effective fundraising activities, ready to commence on March 1st.
